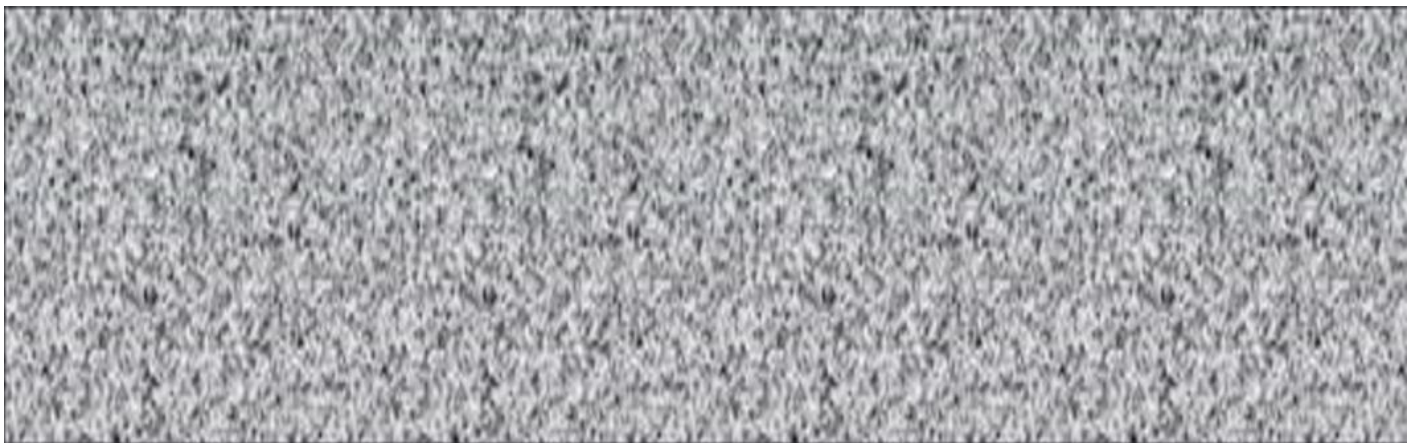
Please Pray for Our Messy Church and Tuesday Tots
