Suggested daily Bible Readings for week beg June 10th

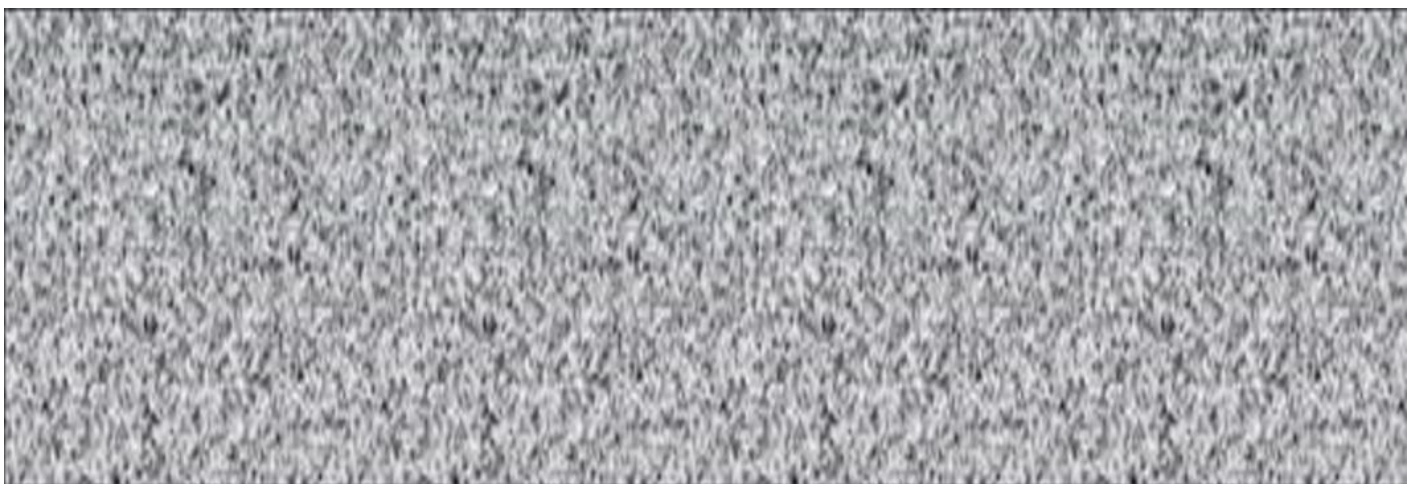
Mon: Acts 2:12-36, Tues: Acts 4:32-End, Wed: Romans 2:1-16,
