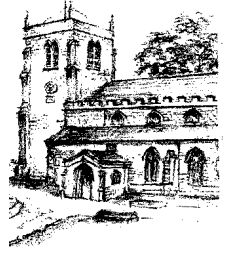


St Mary's Church Arnold

This includes a midday meal, Afternoon Teas and lots of activities.

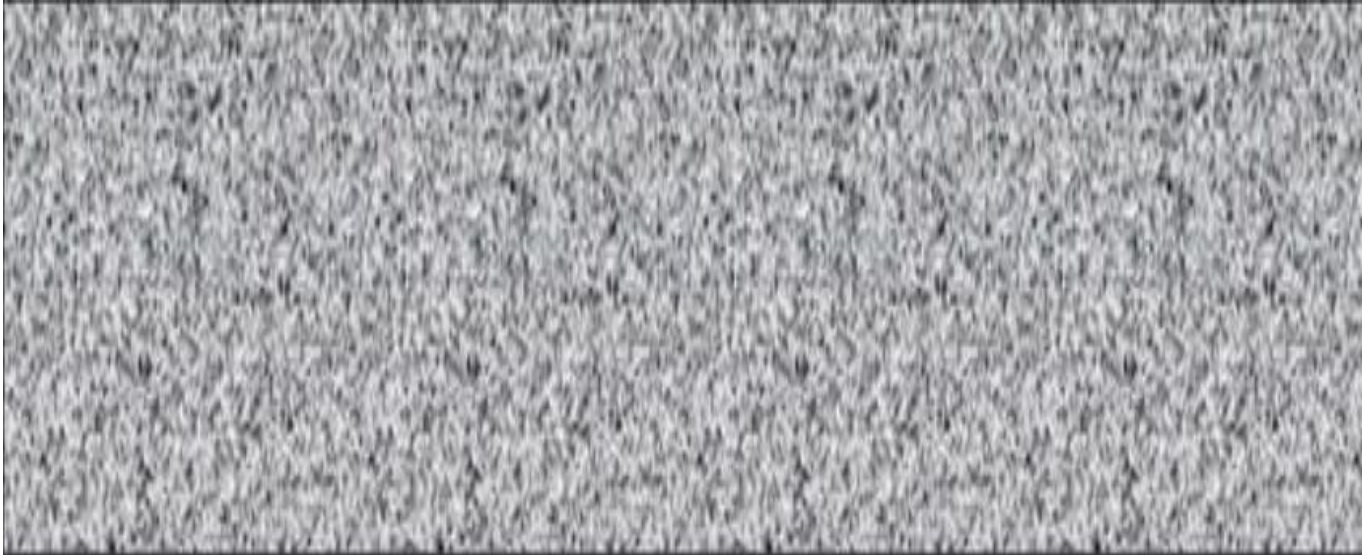
