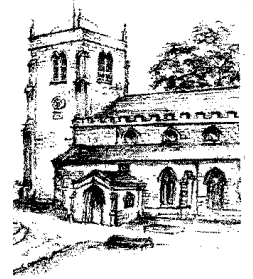


# St Mary's Church Arnold

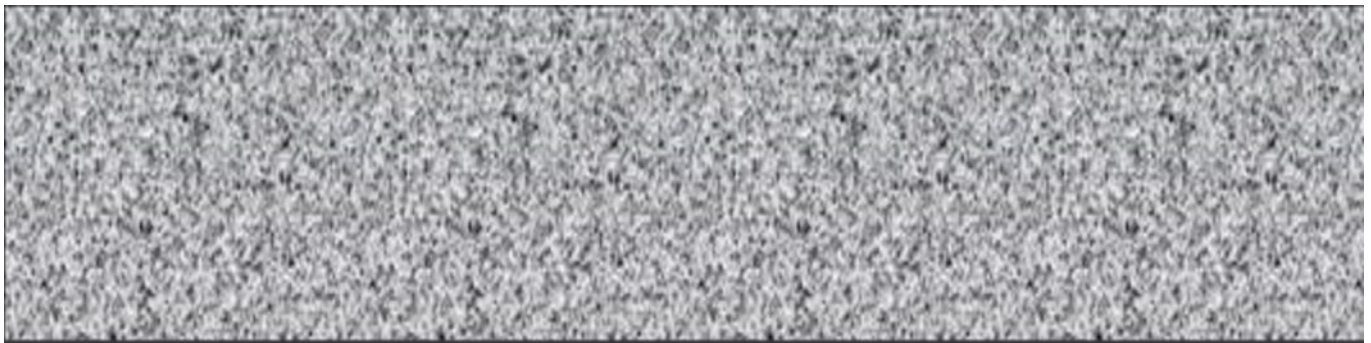
## Remembrance Service

*Our service of Remembrance is on Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> November at 9.30am. It will be a service of Holy Communion. After the service we will process out of church to the front lawn where the Act of Remembrance will take place around a large cross. This year marks 100 years of remembering those who gave their lives in the service of the nation. To mark this we are inviting those who would wish to, to bring a large poppy which we will place in the grass around the cross at the end of the service. It would be lovely if we could manage 100 poppies. The children in the uniformed groups have been invited to attend and have also been asked to bring along poppies which they may make in their groups if they wish. A regular bought poppy attached to a small green garden cane or a poppy made from card or tissue paper would be great. After the outside Act of Remembrance there will be a short All Age service in church followed by refreshments.*
