St Mary's Fellowship will meet for lunch at Coopers Brook (formerly Old Spot) on Wednesday September 5th at 12noon.

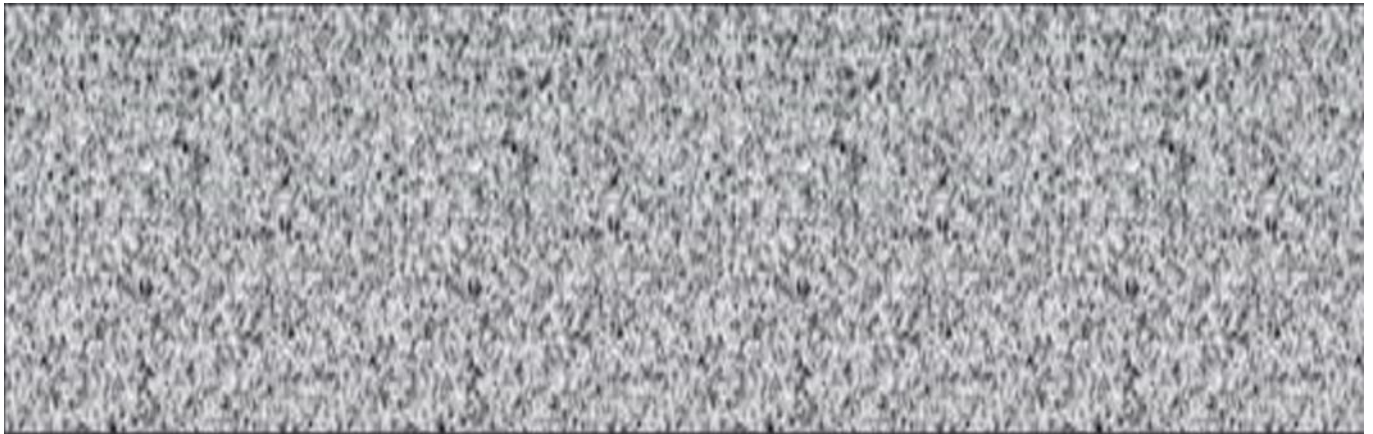
